Elementary Honors Programs K-4th Grades

Middle School Acceleration Program Mathematics 5th-8th Grades

The Zachary Community School District recognizes that students who demonstrate high potential in mathematics are ready for challenges beyond the state standards for their grade level. For these students, Zachary offers an Accelerated Math curriculum beginning in grade five. In Zachary, we strive to meet students where they are and inspire them to progress to the next level and beyond. For this reason, students are most successful when they are appropriately placed in mathematics, based on their development and demonstrated mastery of content standards. The Accelerated Math program enables highly motivated students who are ahead to continue to grow and thrive in these areas.

Additional Accelerated Program Services 9th-12th Grades

Includes Honors classes, Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, and Career and Technical Education programs and certifications.

The Advanced Placement (AP) program at Zachary High School offers more than 10 AP, college-level courses.
