

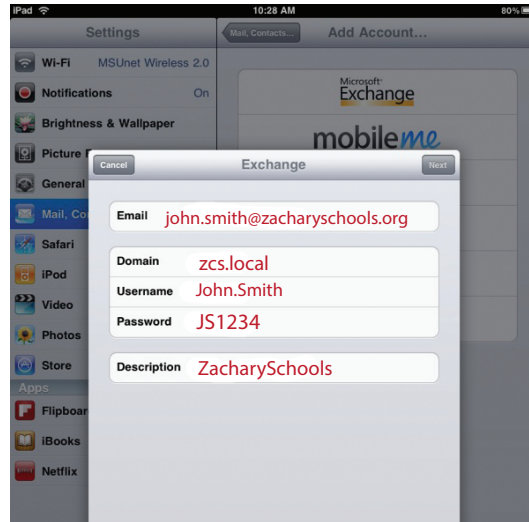
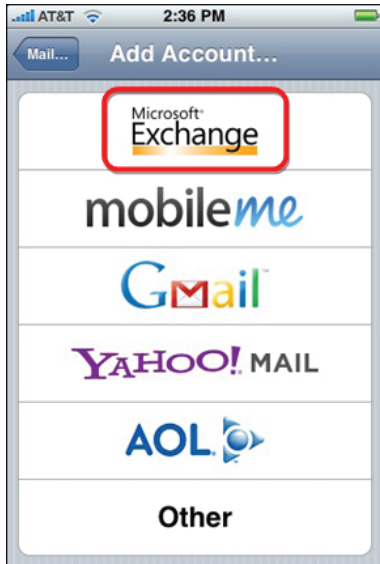
Mobile Device Email Setup
