2022-2023 Zachary High School Stadium Guidelines

It is an exciting time around Zachary High School as we prepare for our first regular season football game of the year. We aim to foster a safe and enjoyable environment where all fans can cheer on our football team. The following guidelines are in place for Zachary High School Stadium events to provide this type of environment:

- ZHS events are on an e-ticket/cashless system. Tickets are on sale at <u>sLocaltix.com</u>. Debit and credit cards are accepted at the game for tickets.
- High school students MUST show their ID to enter the stadium. Students who fail to provide their school ID will not be permitted.
 - o High school students MUST show their ID to sit in the designated high school section in the bleachers.
- Elementary and middle school students must be accompanied by a parent/guardian, or they will not be admitted into the stadium.
 - Elementary and middle school students must sit with their parent(s)/guardian(s).
 - Parents/Guardians are responsible for students' behavior and are responsible for their supervision during the game.
- Fans will not be allowed to congregate anywhere in the stadium, including but not limited to walkways and restroom areas.
- No loitering is permitted. Students/Spectators must sit in the stands. Aisles must be kept clear. Congregating under the bleachers or around the concession areas will not be allowed.
- Students/Spectators who throw food, drink, or other items will be immediately escorted from the stadium, will not be allowed re-admittance, and may be banned from the stadium for the remainder of the school year.
- Any individual who refuses to comply with stadium officials' directions will be immediately escorted from the stadium, will not be allowed re-admittance, and may be banned from the stadium for the remainder of the school year.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, and weapons are strictly prohibited.
- Any ZCSD student currently serving a suspension or expulsion is not permitted to attend events.
- ZCSD has a zero-tolerance policy for fighting. Offenders will be ejected, arrested, and subjected to disciplinary action by the school.
- Anyone leaving the stadium cannot re-enter unless a new ticket is purchased.

All individuals who refuse to comply with stadium officials' directions will be immediately escorted from the stadium, will not be allowed re-admittance, and may be banned from the stadium for the remainder of the school year. Bronco Stadium is an extension of all ZCSD campuses, and all school/campus rules apply.
